# Special Rules

#### Anti-tank Platoon (8th Army) - p.145

British Portee anti-tank guns use the Tip and Run special rule on page 246 of the rulebook.

#### Anti-tank Platoon, Royal Artillery (8th Army) - p.153

British Portee anti-tank guns use the Tip and Run special rule (see page 246 of the rulebook).

#### Armoured Car Platoon (8th Army) - p.151

Armoured Car Platoons are Reconnaissance Platoons.

#### Field Battery, Royal Artillery (8th Army) - p.156

Although a Field Battery Royal Artillery Royal, Horse Artillery Battery, or Medium Battery, Royal Artillery is a single Support choice, each Gun Troop operates as a separate platoon with its own Command Team. The HQ Troop Command team and Staff team are Independent teams. If the HQ Troop Command team joins a Gun Troop, it becomes the Platoon Command team. Although thay count as seperate platoon for all other purposes, a Field Battery Royal Artillery Royal, Horse Artillery Battery, or Medium Battery, Royal Artillery deploys as a single platoon, all at the same time. For example, both Gun Troops are treated as a single platoon when calculating the number of platoons held in Ambush or Reserve.

#### Medium Battery, Royal Artillery (8th Army) - p.157

You may not field a Medium Battery, Royal Artillery unless you are also fielding a Field Battery, Royal Artillery with at least as many guns.

### Rifle Company HQ (8th Army) - p.143

When attached to Rifle Platoons, the Light Motar or Blacker Bombard teams become part of the platoon for all purposes.
